## Twenty Texas Startups Compete for up to \$1.9 Million at Texas A&M New Ventures Competition

[COLLEGE STATION, Texas] - Twenty of Texas' most promising science- and engineering-focused startups are set to compete for over \$550,000 in guaranteed prizes, with up to \$1.9 million in total value available at the 11<sup>th</sup> annual Texas A&M New Ventures Competition (TNVC) taking place at Ford Hall of Champions at Kyle Field on May 14-15, 2025. The prize pool includes guaranteed cash awards and a wide array of sponsored prizes, services, and investment opportunities. This is the culmination of a rigorous, 4-month process that is supported by The Texas A&M University System and over 25 sponsors.

TNVC, hosted by Texas A&M Innovation, will bring together entrepreneurs, judges, and industry leaders. Sixteen <u>startups</u> (and four alternates) from Bryan, College Station, Austin, North Texas, Houston and San Antonio, representing diverse sectors including medical devices, energy, information technology, and transportation, will present their ideas to expert judges. After rigorous screening, due diligence, and coaching these finalists emerged from a pool of over 70 applicants.

The highlight of the event will be the final presentations commencing at 2:00 PM on the second day of the competition, followed by elevator pitches, and the awards ceremony, where the six top finalists will compete for cash prizes. All competitors are eligible for an additional elevator pitch and sponsored prize pool up to \$1.9 million in value.
